Later Board of studies Members had in detailed discussion and reviewed each item of the proposed agenda and finally the following items have been resolved unanimously by all the members of BOS to implement from the academic year 2019-20 onwards.

The following resolutions are approved after careful discussion and observations.

1. The board approved the existing MBA Schema, regulations and the syllabus with 104 credits of MR18 Regulations for 2019-20 admitted Batch also with the following suggestions to be implemented in the coming regulations;
 - To mention E-Learning platforms related to various specialisation areas.

- As some of the topics of Project management are already covered in the earlier papers of I and II semesters the board suggested offering other subject to avoid duplication.
 - In Employee relations and Labour laws it is suggested to add all latest enactments of Labour Laws.
 - Include entrepreneurship subject in first year to give the scope of learning entrepreneurship to take that as a specialisation.
 - Inclusion of more text books written by foreign authors in the reference list.
2. The BOS has approved the MR18 syllabus of the B.Tech. Subjects offered by MBA department as per the guide lines of the UGC, AICTE & JNTUH, Hyderabad for the academic year 2019-20 also.
 3. The BOS members have agreed to suggest a panel for paper setters and Valuers /examiners for both theory and practical of all the subjects of MBA programme and subjects offered to B.Tech (UG) and M.Tech (PG)
