1. The BOS has collectively resolved to implement this scheme of Instructions, periods per week and number of credits for the first year B. Tech (CE) Course from the academic year 2020-21 onwards.
2. The BOS Members have thoroughly reviewed and discussed the Scheme of instructions, periods per week, and number of credits for the B.Tech.(CE) course of the proposed MR20 Regulations for the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year.
3. The BOS Members unanimously approved the inclusion of Artificial Intelligence in the V Semester and Cyber Security in the VI Semester of MR18 Regulations as recommended by JNTUH.
4. The BOS members have agreed to suggest a panel for paper setters and valuers / examiners for both theory and practical of all the subjects of B. Tech (CE) Course.

6. The BOS has also resolved for delegation of power to the Chairman of BOS for inclusion / exclusion / modification of any of the above item as per the requirements.


**The following suggestions were made by the members of the Board of Studies for the proposed MR20 Structure.**

1. The Fundamentals of Data Structures Lab has to be reduced to 1 credit out of 2 proposed and 1 credit can be added to Computer-Aided Drafting of Buildings Lab in the III Semester.
2. The Fundamentals of Data Structures Lab can be renamed as Basic Data Structures Lab.
3. The Revit Architecture with Interior Design Lab proposed in the IV Semester can be renamed as Architecture and Interior Design Lab.
4. The Object Oriented Programming through JAVA Lab in IV Semester can be renamed as Basics of Programming through JAVA and credits reduced to 1 and Concrete Technology and Highway Materials Lab can be increased to 2 credits.
5. The Gender Sensitization Lab in IV Semester can be renamed as Gender Sensitization since no Practical Hours are allotted.
6. It was suggested that Co-curricular Activity need not be mentioned in the syllabus.


7. The Professional Elective – I proposed in V Semester can be swapped with Environmental Engineering in VI Semester.

10. Principles of Bridge Engineering can be renamed as Bridge Engineering in Semester VIII.


