The 8th Board of studies meeting for the CE (UG) - BOS was conducted on 30-06-2017 at 10:30 AM in the conference hall, Malla Reddy Engineering College (Autonomous), Hyderabad.

The following is the agenda for the meeting.

1. Discussion and approval of the course structure and syllabus of B.Tech. – Civil Engineering for the Academic year 2017-2018.
2. Formations of Scheme of Instructions, periods/week and the number of credits allotted for B.Tech.
3. Detailed syllabus of the following courses B.Tech (Civil Engineering).
4. Suggestion and approval of Open Source Software for suitable lab experiments.
5. Delegation of power to the chairman, BOS for inclusion and exclusion of the names of the panel of paper setters, valuers of both theory and practical's.
6. Any other item with the permission of the chair.

At the outset, Dr. R. Prasanna Kumar, Professor & HOD and Chairman of the CE (UG) - Board of Studies, welcomed the members to the BOS meeting and informed the purpose of the meeting. He also briefed about the previous BOS meeting resolutions and placed on record the existing syllabus of MR15 regulations and also proposed modifications for MR17 regulations syllabus (Batches admitting from 2017-18 onwards). Later Board of studies Members has in detailed discussed, reviewed each item of the proposed agenda and finally the following items have been resolved unanimously by all the members of BOS to implement from the academic year 2017-18 and onwards.


The following resolutions are made after careful discussion and observations.

1. The BOS Members have thoroughly reviewed and discussed the Scheme of instructions, periods per week, and number of credits for all 4 years of B.Tech. (CE) Course as per the guide lines of the AICTE and JNTUH, Hyderabad. The BOS has collectively resolved to implement this scheme of Instructions, periods per week and number of credits for all 4 years of B.Tech. (CE) Courses from the academic year 2017-18 onwards. The devised scheme of instructions and other items have been given in Annexure-I.
2. After formulation of scheme of Instructions, the BOS has reviewed and devised the syllabus for B.Tech. (CE) Course as per the guide lines of the AICTE and JNTUH, Hyderabad.
3. The BOS has discussed and framed the syllabus of the B.Tech. Open Electives offered to the other Engineering branches as per the guide lines of the AICTE & JNTUH, Hyderabad and resolved to implement from the academic year 2017-18 onwards.
4. The BOS Members unanimously approved to use the following Open Source softwares for execution of programmes in the respective laboratories.
Auto CAD, MicroBEAM 4.10, ARC GIS.
5. The BOS members have agreed to suggest a panel for paper setters and valuers /examiners for both theory and practical of all the subjects of B.Tech.(CE) Course.
6. The BOS has also resolved for delegation of power to the Chairman of BOS for inclusion/exclusion/modification of any of the above item as per the requirements.

The following suggestions were made by the members of the Board of studies.

1. In the subject Law for Engineers BOS members suggested adding one unit related to arbitration in construction projects and safety measures.
2. Audit course and mandatory courses may be identified with the parent department teaching the course and in the remarks column it may be mentioned as AC/MC. This may be decided in consultation with all other departments concerned.
3. Course code may be fixed with the specific letter identifying the department. eg.: CE, HS etc.
4. Number of lecture for Analytical Subjects may be increased to 3 or 4 minimum in addition to tutorial hours.
5. In place of Structural Analysis Laboratory members suggested to introduce Survey Laboratory II.
6. Entrepreneurship subject with one credit may be allotted internal and external marks in proportion to credits.
7. Environmental Engineering I & II may be combined into one subject and in that slot Advanced Structural Analysis may be introduced.
8. In surveying syllabus one unit on Total Station may be exclusively taught.
9. UPSC and State Syllabus can be compared with our syllabus and a minimum of 60% may be ensured.

Finally, Dr. R. Prasanna Kumar, Chairman – CE(UG) Board of Studies has expressed his sincere thanks to all the Members of the Board of studies for their active participation and contribution. The meeting concluded at 11:30 PM.
